Program Includes:

The college offers under graduation, post-graduation, Doctoral and Diploma courses. It has five disciplines viz, Arts, Science, Commerce, Education and Journalism. A three year degree course BAJMC affiliated to Khushabhau Thakrey PatraKarita Avam Jansanchar Vishwavidyalaya, Raipur is functional since 2006. The college has nine research centres. The College ensures decentralized and participatory form of governance in providing quality education. Various academic and NAAC oriented committees are functional in the college

Facilities available in the college –

- 1. Wi-Fi campus with WI-FI speed enhanced from 25mbps to 50mbps.
- 2. Central Library equipped with SOUL Software, N-List, subscription of e-Books ,New text books and Departmental Library in all Post- Graduate subjects. Gym with modern equipment. Women's Hostel with 100 seats , Auditorium, seminar halls, well equipped laboratories, language lab etc.
- 3. Kalyan Amritasan Refreshment Center and Jawara Juice Center.
- 4. The facility of PNB ATM in the college premises, vehicle parking (separate parking for girls, boys and staff. CCTV camera installed in required places, Generator facility available. Nine Acre playground with 4 turf pitches, volleyball ground, basket ball ground in the college campus. Various State level/Inter college cricket matches are held. Separate administrative blocks, Sarvdham Sambhav and Radhakrishinan garden.

Remarkable achievements of the current session 2021-22

Research Centre- Kalyan post graduate college has nine recognized research centres in Education, English, Hindi, Commerce Sociology, Political science, Economic, Chemistry and Mathematics discipline respectively. Institution has 33 research guide and 58 research guide from other institutes are also registered in our research centre's. Research scholars carry out fundamental and applied research in various thrust area. **Two hundred twenty nine research scholars** are enrolled in research centers of the college.

- 1. **Faculty of Education** This department has the maximum number of 13 research guides. It is the biggest research center under Hemchand Yadav University.
- 2. Welfare measures were undertaken by institution for teaching and non teaching staff. Employee state insurance corporation (ESIC), Medical leave, Travelling allowances, Fee Concession for their wards, Festival advances, EPF, CPF, Earned leave etc. are some of the examples.

During this Session, major maintenance work completed which included Building, Garden, Gym, Computer maintenances, website maintenances worth of rupees 3,79,396/- b. under infrastructure augmentation some office equipments, library book, laboratory apparatus etc worth of rupees 4,82,9331/-
- 5. For student support Student oriented committee like internal complaint committee, anti ragging committee, student grievance committee, discipline committee, etc helped in assurance in democratic and participating student friendly environment in college campus. Various government and non government scholarship have provided 630 students were benefited by government scholarship worth of Rs 18 lacs during the session 21-22.
- 6. Workshop, short term courses, conferences, webinar, seminar, and faculty development programme (FDP). Twenty Six teachers have attended online webinar, seminar, faculty development programme and short term courses during this session.
- 7. **Departmental society activities** Various extension activities were conducted by departments during this session like Ann Daan and Vastra Dan Yojana, Tree plantation, Health checkup camps, Shahid Vinod Choubey Scholarship by political science department, "Best from Waste material" by Botanical society etc.
