

STUDENT FEEDBACK ABOUT COLLEGE (2017-18)

1. Quality of teaching learning process is considered Good by 65% of the undergraduate students and 15% of students considered teaching learning process as average. 69% of post graduate students considered it as Good.
2. 45% undergraduate student agreed that their grievances are redressed sometime. On the contrary 80% post graduate students agreed that grievances are redressed on priority basis only 2% post graduate considered it as never.
3. 82% of the students considered learning opportunities provided by college satisfactory only 10% considered it as excellent and only 8% considered it as General.
4. 90% of postgraduate students considered it as satisfactory and only 10% considered it as General.
5. 85% of the students agreed that curriculum is skill based and 10% considered it as upgraded and only 5% considered it as general. 80% of the post graduate students agreed that curriculum is skill based 15% considered it as upgraded and only 5% considered it as General.
6. 88% of students marked infrastructure of the college including ICT as very good only 7% considered it as general. 90% of the post graduate students agreed that infrastructure is good only 8% considered it as satisfactory and 2% considered it as general.
7. 52% of the under graduate students agreed that e-resources in library is sufficient and 40% of the students has marked it as general and only 8% considered it as insufficient. 60% of the post graduate students agreed that e-resources in library is sufficient, 35% agreed for general and 5% considered as insufficient.
8. 86% of undergraduate student considered evaluation process of college as always fair, 12% considered it as sometimes fair and only 2% considered it as sometime unfair. 76% of postgraduate considered it always fair and 30% of postgraduate students considered it as sometimes unfair.
9. 95% of students considered that college environment is Democratic, Academic, Secure and Women friendly 3% of students considered it as democratic, Academic and secure and 2% of the students has not given any response. 97% of postgraduate

students considered college environment as democratic, Academic, secure and women friendly.

10. Overall students facilities and support is considered very effective by 72% of the students 30% considered it as General.

SUGGESTIONS RECEIVED

- i. More ICT usage by teachers
- ii. PG students demanded more field work/ Internship
- iii. More skill based short term courses to be opened
- iv. More classrooms to be constructed to prevent over crowding.
- v. More subscription of e-books/ journals.
- vi. Security to be tighten in parking area.

ACTION TAKEN

- i. Multipurpose digital room established in Hindi Department. It is beneficial for all departments.
- ii. More project works demanding fieldworks initiated in many departments.
- iii. Class room construction started under RUSA, Power saving LED bulbs installed.
- iv. SOUL-2 software installed in the library.
- v. Modification in internal marking system.

STUDENTS FEEDBACK ABOUT TEACHERS (2017-18)

1. Teachers quality of teaching has been considered good by 78% of the undergraduate students. 22% considered it as average. 62% of the post graduate students considered it as good and only 12% considered it as average.
2. Subjective knowledge of teacher and ability to generate curiosity among students is considered good by 67% of the student and 30% considered it as average, 72% of the post graduate student considered it as good and 32% considered it as average.
3. Teachers ability to identify strength and weakness of students has been considered Good by 63% of the students only 24% considered it as average. 73% of the post graduate student considered it as good and 22% of post graduate students considered it as average.

4. 48% of the students considered teachers preparation for the class is good, 52% of the students considered it as average, 56 % of the post graduate students considered it as good only 36% students considered it as average.
5. 83% of students agreed that teachers are available in class and outside the class for motivation, skill development etc. only 10% considered it as average, 92% post graduate students agreed with above point only 5% postgraduate students considered it as average.
6. 42% of undergraduate students agree that ICT usage by teachers as Good Only 38% students considered it as average 74% of postgraduate students marked it as good only 30% of postgraduate students marked it as average.
7. 53% students agreed that teachers use inactive teaching methodologies as good only 20% consider it as average and 5% consider it as poor, 62% post graduate students consider the usage of innovative teaching methodologies as good and 30% consider it as average.
8. Mentoring by teachers are considered as Good by 86% of the students, 8% consider it as average, 92% of the post graduate students consider it as Good and 5% consider it as average.
9. The formative and summative evaluation by teacher is considered as good by 68% of the students and 23% considered it as average, 87% of the post graduate student considered it as good only 5% of the post graduate students considered it as average.

SUGGESTIONS RECEIVED-

1. More use of English Language by teachers during teaching.
2. More ICT usage by teachers.

ACTION TAKEN

1. Multipurpose digital room construction for e-classes.
2. Laptop in each department provided.
3. Staff encouraged for usage of English during teaching.
4. Teachers encourage for the use of new teaching methodologies

STUDENTS FEEDBACK ABOUT CURRICULUM (2017-18)

90% of the students considered that syllabus developed life and employability skills. 88% of the under graduate students and 82% of the post graduate students felt that

syllabus is easy to understand and career oriented, 76% of the undergraduate PG students agreed that syllabus is related to real life and is applicable in real life. 78% UG students agreed that syllabus provided opportunity for project/ field work, 62% post graduate students agreed for it and 26% students marked average. 82% of the undergraduate students are satisfied with the clarity, relatedness and availability of resources related to syllabus, 86% PG students agree for above point. 90% of the undergraduate student considered that syllabus is relevant in present context, 78% post graduate students consider syllabus as relevant and 30% post graduate students suggested improvement.

SUGGESTIONS RECEIVED

More career oriented courses to be started.

ALUMNI FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM (2017-18)

92% of alumni strongly agree that syllabus created interest to pursue post graduation and research, 87% agreed that syllabus helped in intellectual development 62% agreed that syllabus was updated and is as per the local/ National and Global needs. Only 54% marked that elective papers helped in developing technical and vocational skills. 88% students agreed that curriculum contributed in inculcating professional and moral/ ethical values and is relevant. Only 58% students satisfied with internship/ field work/ project. 86% students are satisfied with the seminar/ workshops/ guest lecture etc.

SUGGESTION RECEIVED

1. More skill based courses to be established
2. Library e-resources to be enhanced.
3. Field work/ Internship to be promoted.

ACTION TAKEN

1. SOUL-2 installed in the library.
2. Project giving emphasis on field work initiated.

PARENTS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM (2017-18)

Syllabus intellectually stimulates was observed by 82% and 10% denied it. 78% found that curriculum is need based Educational Objectives are not cleared to 32% of the parents, 65% of parents fully understand and satisfied with the learning objectives, 80%

parents satisfied with the knowledge level of their children. Inclusion of modern trends in curriculum was considered satisfactory by 79 of the parents, 68% appreciated that their children search for other resources. Most of the parents felt that syllabus should be revised . Only 26% of the parents interacted with teachers, 82% parents marked that curriculum helped their children in learning technology. Employability of the syllabus was considered satisfactory by 56% of the parents and others felt improvement needed 76% of the parents felt that curriculum inculcates human values.

ACTION TAKEN

TEACHERS FEEDBACK ABOUT INSTITUTION(2017-18)

62% of teaching staff consider that provision for professional development are non discriminatory and fair.26% consider it as not fair.68% are not satisfied with the financial support by institution for projects and research.86% of teachers consider that administrative and academic environment is teacher friendly92% teachers agree that they have freedom to adopt new methodologies,strategies and techniques of teaching.88% teachers agree that institution encourages teachers for participation in seminars/workshops and conferences.53% agree that they have freedom for suggestion and modification in curriculum.95% teachers are satisfied with the infrastructural facilities for them.Only 56% teachers are satisfied with the encouragement they get for their efforts.48% teachers are not satisfied with the redressal of their grievances and 64% teachers are satisfied with the ICT facilities in the institution.

SUGGESTIONS RECEIVED-

- 1.Financial support should be provided for attending seminars/conferences.
- 2.Faculty development programme should be organized in the institution.

ACTION TAKEN-

It has been decided by the governing body to provide financial help for attending seminars/conferences/workshops etc.

TEACHERS FEEDBACK ON CURRICULUM-

86% teachers strongly agree that course outcomes are well defined and clear.90% teachers agree that curriculum is balanced with regards to the theoretical and practical knowledge.52% agree that pedagogy proposed matches the curriculum.55% teachers

suggested that syllabus should be more skill based.68% teachers agree that curriculum is as per need of students and is revised/updated as per need.Maximum teachers are satisfied with the optional papers.58% teachers are satisfied with the availability of books/relevant content materials in the library.

Suggestion received-

- 1.Enhancement of books/e-resources in library.
- 2.skill based certificate courses to be offered.

ACTION TAKEN-

SOUL-2 software installed in library,subscription of e-books etc.
